

# Waste water recycling and leather solid waste utilization technology training is to be conducted

Addis Ababa 08, August 2014: Leather Industry Development Institute (LIDI) in collaboration with the Chinese Leather & Footwear Industry Research Institute (CLFIRI) will conduct training on Waste Water Recycling and Leather Solid Waste Utilization Technology.

On the awareness creation meeting which was held at the institute's hall, LIDI'S Product & Productivity Sector coordinator, Ato Berhanu Negus, said the corporation between the two institutes is start to be effective. "I hope we will bring change in the sector together," Ato Berhanu added.



Ethiopia and China have strengthened their ties in many aspects and the newly created partnership in the leather sector is also further accelerating the countries mutual benefits, he said.

LIDI and CLFIRI have started their bilateral cooperation in tannery waste management since December 2013 when CLFIRI delegates visited Ethiopia and discussed with LIDI's management.

According to Ato Berhanu the training which will start at the end of August 2014 incorporates 20 experts from LIDI and the Tanneries in three phases.

On the one day awareness creation training; the technology of recycling of liming waste water and chrome waste water, the technology of utilization of leather solid waste and technology of waste water treatment was given by technologists from CLFIRI.
